

PRIVACY POLICY

related to the Teyuto S.r.l. Newsletter

The Teyuto S.r.l. newsletter (hereinafter, "**Teyuto**") is published on the website and distributed by e-mail – automatically and free of charge – to those who request to receive it by filling in the form on the page of the website www.teyuto.com (hereinafter, "**Site**").

Teyuto, with registered office in via Ippolito Pindemonte n. 63, 50124, Firenze (FI) – VAT and Tax Code: 06781570483, acts as the data controller of the personal data of the customer/user and of any co-obligors (jointly referred to as the "**Data Subject/s**") and can be contacted at the e-mail address dpo@teyuto.com.

The data requested and collected through the newsletter subscription form (name and e-mail contact) will be processed for the purpose of promoting products and services offered by Teyuto and carrying out market research aimed at making promotional activities more focused on the needs, habits and interests of the Data Subjects.

The legal basis of such processing is to be found in the consent provided by the Data Subject by filling in the form and the request for activation of the newsletter service, pursuant to and for the purposes of the Article 6, par. 1, lett. a) 2016/679 EU Regulation (hereinafter "**GDPR**").

The data will be processed for the sole purpose of providing the Newsletter service and will be kept for a maximum period of 24 months from the expression of consent by the Data Subject.

The consent given by the Data Subject may be revoked at any time by submitting a written request to the e-mail address dpo@teyuto.com: if the Data Subject denies his/her consent to the Newsletter service, he/she will no longer receive commercial communications and related services.

The data may be processed with manual or automated tools, suitable to guarantee security, confidentiality and to prevent unauthorized access. The data will be processed exclusively by Teyuto's staff and collaborators and/or by the companies expressly appointed as data processors (e.g. for technological maintenance of the Site).

The data may be freely transferred outside the national territory to countries within the European Union.

Related to this, it is specified that for the provision of the newsletter service, Teyuto relies on the support of Acumbamail, a company under Spanish law, with servers within the EU territory (for more details on the mentioned provider, please consult this [link](#)).

The Data Subject shall have the right to obtain the full list of the subjects appointed as data processors, a copy of the data held abroad and to obtain information about the place where such data is stored by making an express request to the Data Controller.

To stop receiving the newsletter, the Data Subject may request cancellation of the service by sending a written request to dpo@teyuto.com. At the same e-mail address, data subjects also have the right to ask the Data Controller, in the cases provided for, for access, rectification, cancellation of personal data, restriction of processing concerning them or to object to processing (Art. 15 et seq. GDPR). Data subjects who believe that the processing of personal data relating to them carried out through this service is in breach of the provisions of the GDPR have the right to lodge a complaint with the Garante, as provided for in Article 77 of the GDPR, or to take legal action (Article 79 of the GDPR).
